1. Click the screen recorder icon and open the recorder website.



2. Launch the Recorder

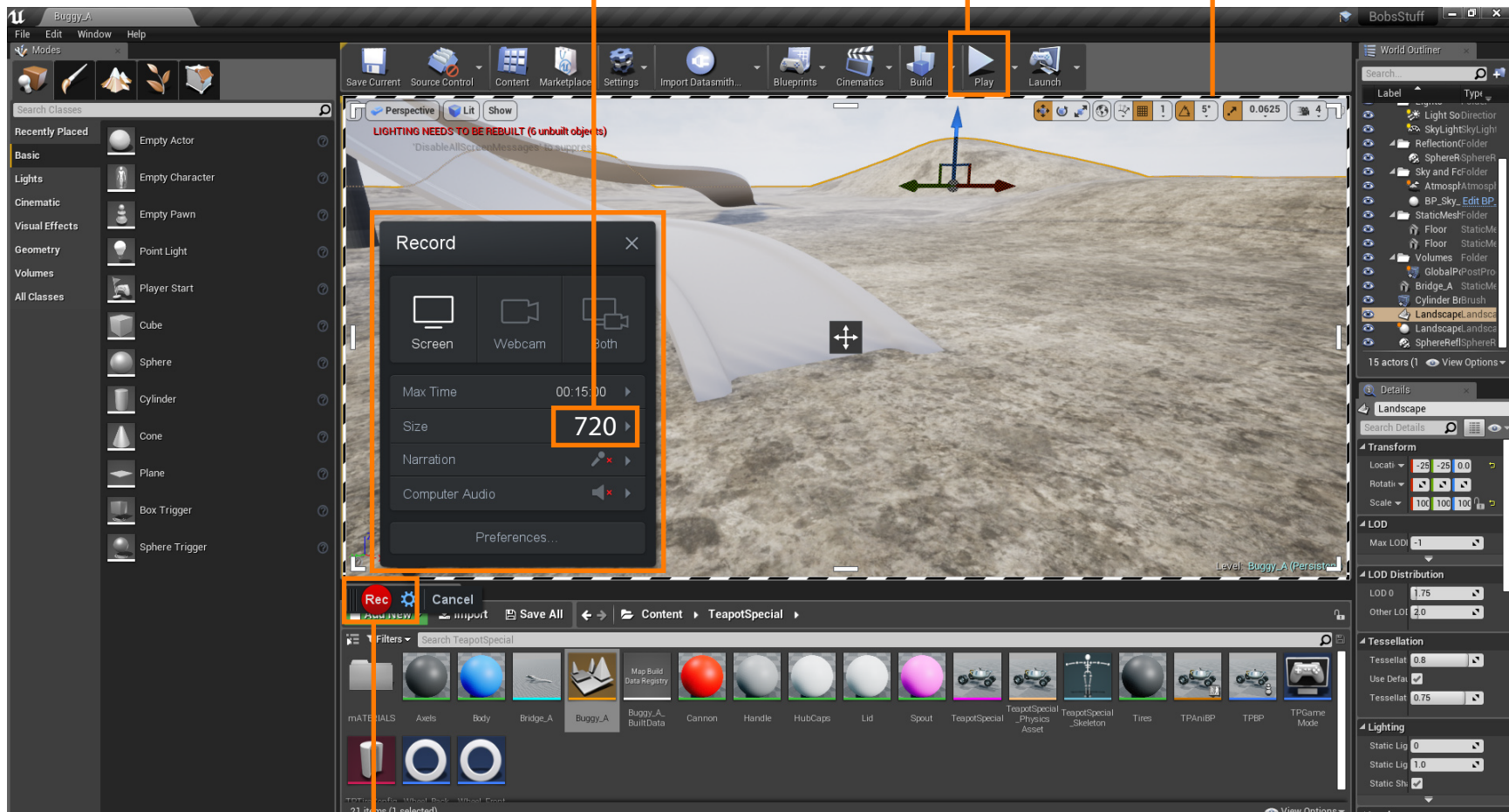
3. Open the Recorder

5. Adjust the black and white dotted line around your game window.

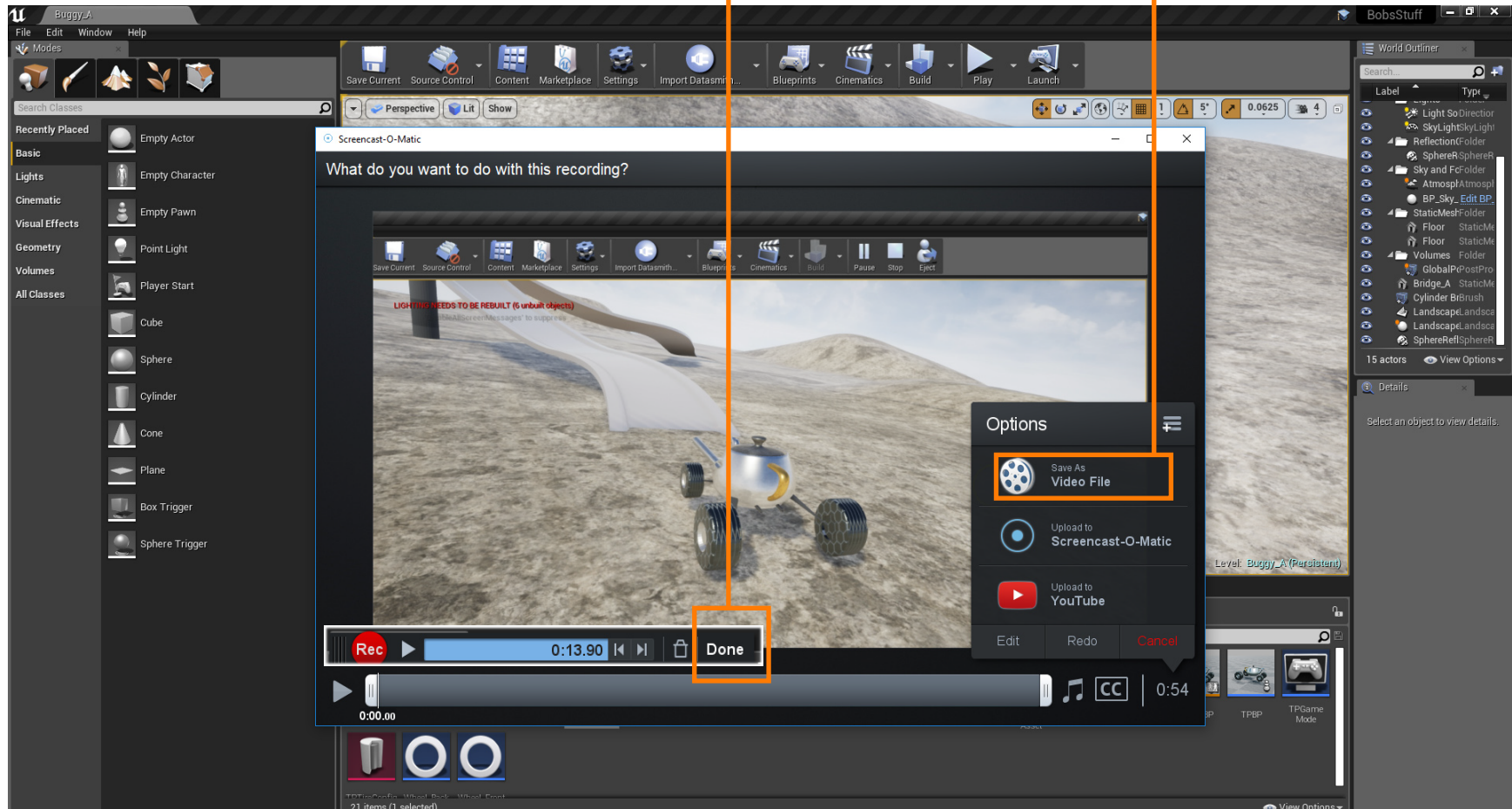
6. Start you game.



7. Click the record button 

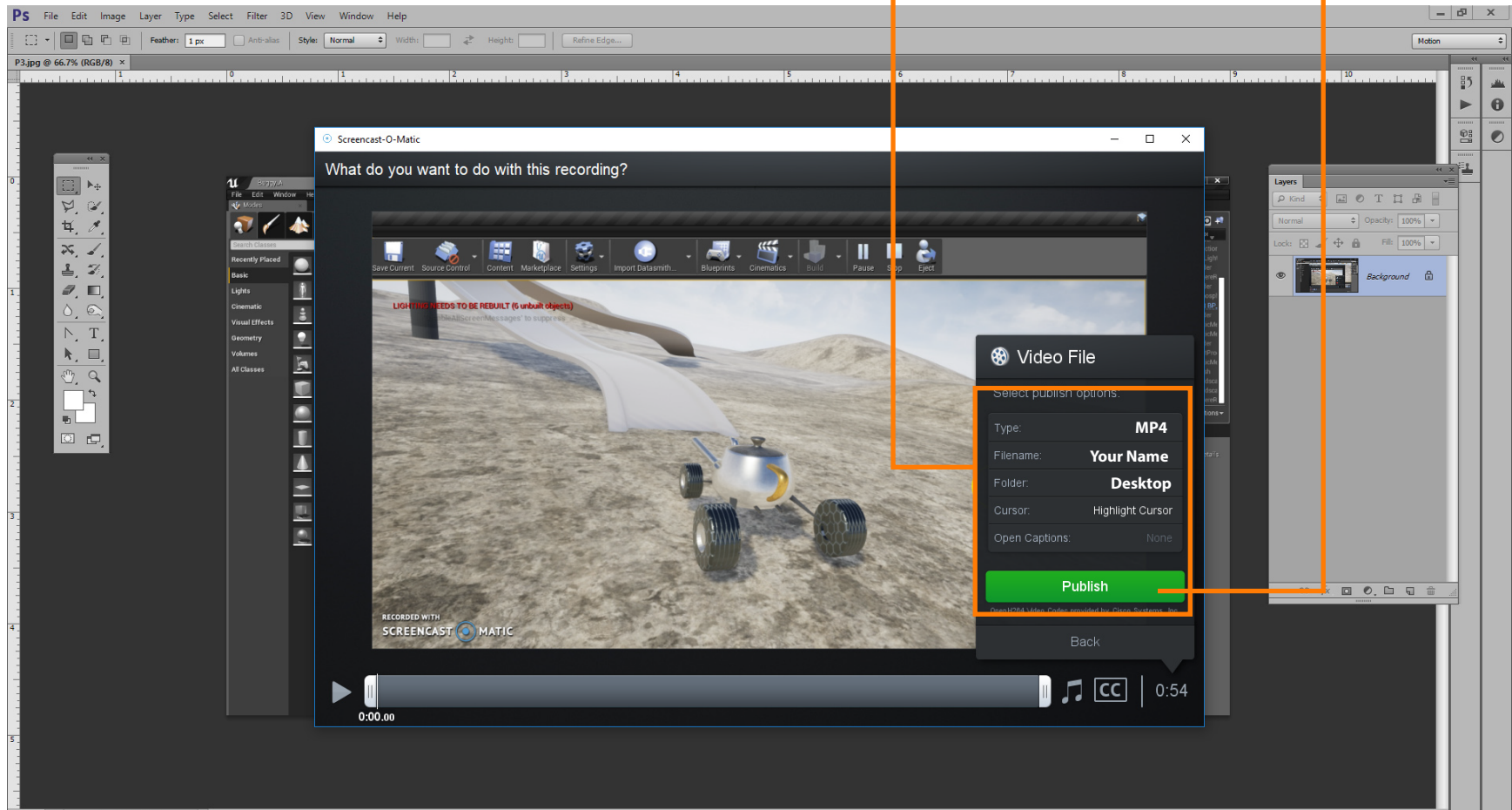
8. When you finish your play, Click "Done".
