

# TYPOGRAPHY -RULES\*

## Rule No. 1- DO NOT use all the fonts in one design.

Simplicity is more attractive than disarray and confusion.

Too many fonts and the message most often gets lost in the jumble.

Use two or three fonts per design.

## Rule No. 2- DO NOT use all capital letters in long text messages.

All cap's in paragraphs makes for difficult reading.

You can use all capitals for headlines and short phrases

Beware... decorative fonts usually look terrible in all cap's.
